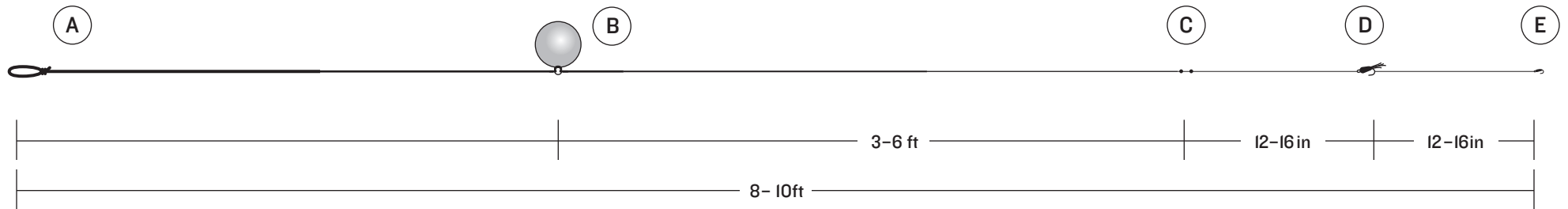


Tandem Nymph Rig:



- A. Leader: 4X or 5X tapered leader 7 to 9 feet long — The diagram below illustrates the connection between the leader to the fly line*
- B. Strike indicator: Small as possible yarn or foam type — I prefer the Thingamabobber® strike indicator — size medium
- C. Split shot: Start with two no. 6 “split shot” weights (about one inch apart) or a single no. 2 — I prefer two smaller weights as apposed to one large weight.
- D. Point fly: This fly is also called an “attractor” size 14 to 16. (Common patterns: San Juan Worm, Egg, Hares Ear, Pheasant Tail or Copper John).
- E. Dropper fly: Size 18 to 22 attached with 5X or 6X tippet. (Common patterns: RS2, WD-40, Zebra Midge, Brassy or Copper John — black, gray, and olive)
